Genuine Community

The invitation to church membership is an invitation to connect yourself to the local church - the body of Christ - in a mutually beneficial way. Membership is declaration of mutual belonging. Are you ready to be part of a genuine community?

Pastoral Care

The Bible calls your pastor a "shepherd" and the body the "flock". Your pastor is accountable to God for your care. Your commitment to church membership is a vote of confidence - you're not just grazing alongside the flock, you're a part of the flock, entrusting yourself to your pastor's care.

Missional Commitment

Jesus gave his disciples - those present and those to come - a mission, and each local church body has a way of expressing it that reflects the community God has made them to be. Are you ready to commit to the mission of inviting others to experience the grace and compassion of Jesus Christ?

- We will rejoice at each other's happiness and endeavor with tenderness and sympathy to bear each other's burdens and sorrows.
- •We will seek, by the power of the Holy Spirit, to live carefully in the world, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, and remembering that, as we have been voluntarily buried by baptism and raised again from the symbolic grave, so there is on us a special obligation now to lead a new and holy life.
- •We will work together for the continuance of faithful evangelical ministry in this church, as we sustain its worship, discipline, doctrines and the ordinances of baptism and communion.
- We will contribute cheerfully and faithfully, by the giving of tithes and offerings, to the support of the ministry, including the expenses of the church, the relief of the poor, and the spread of the gospel through all nations.

May the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with us all. Amen.
